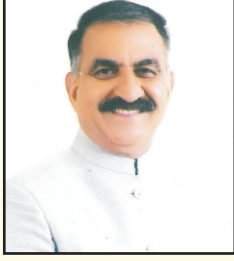

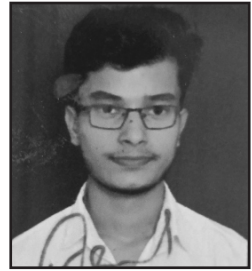

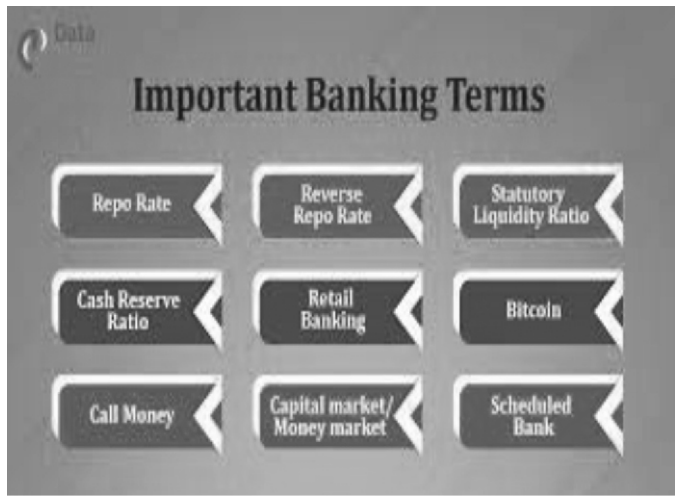

1. NEFT (National Electronic Funds Transfer) NEFT is an electronic means to transfer money from one bank to another or within the same branch. Depending on the bank, NEFT charges and the minimum amount that can be transferred may vary.



2. RTGS (Real Time Gross Settlement) is a fund transfer technology used by banks for same bank or interbank fund transfer.

3. KYC-KYC (Know Your Customer) is a procedure that all banks undergo in order to establish the current identity of a customer. This is to ensure that no fraudulent operations are taking place in the bank.

4. Plastic Money - This is reference to currency used by individuals other than hard cash. Mostly it is used to refer to debit and credit cards.

5. Bank Rate - This is the rate of interest that the RBI levies on banks if they wish to borrow money.

6. Bank Ombudsman - A bank ombudsman is the authority to look into complaints if in case other mode of complaints haven't worked out for the customer.

7. Repo Rate - Repo rate is the rate at which the central bank of a country (RBI) lends money to commercial bank in the event of any shortfall of funds.

8. MICRO Finance - Small loan provided to the poor in urban, rural and sub-urban parts of the country in order to help them raise their income level is known as micro financing.

The rate at which purchasing power drops can be reflected in the average price increase of a basket of selected goods and services over some period of time. An increase in the supply of money is the root of inflation though this can play out through different mechanisms in the economy. A country's money supply can be increased by monetary authorities by:

1. Printing and giving away more money to citizens.
2. Legally devolving the legal tender currency.
3. Learning new money into existence as reserve account credits through the banking system by purchasing government bonds from banks on the secondary market.

In all of these cases, the money ends up losing its purchasing power.

Kerala Govt. on technical grounds from continuing its investigation. In 2018, the Supreme Court, awarded Narayanan a compensation of Rs. 50 lakh and Kerala Govt. also awarded him a compensation of Rs. 1.3 crore.

And at last he was awarded with the Padma Bhushan in 2019.

He was born on 7th November 1888 to Chandrasekhara Ramanathan Iyer and Parvathi Ammal at Trichinopoly, Tamil Nadu. His full name was Chandrashekhara Venkitta Raman. He was the second child of eight siblings and his elder brother was Subramanyan. His father was a teacher in a local institute. When Raman was three years old, his father got an offer from Mrs. AV Narasimha Rao College, Waltair for faculty position. The family travelled from Trichinopoly to Waltair by cart. His father served as lecturer of Physics and Mathematics in the college at Waltair. In 1907 CV Raman married Lokasundari Ammal, daughter of Mr. S Krishnaswamy Iyer, Superintendent of Sea Customs in Madras. CV Raman had two sons namely Chandrashekhara and Radhakrishnan. Raman inherited scientific temper to study Astronomy, Physics, Mathematics and Acoustics from his childhood. His childhood interests became his research passion. Sir CV Raman was an illuminating genius and a devoted scientist, who made towering contributions in the development of science in India. He worked on different fields such as musical acoustics, light scattering, crystal dynamics and optics. He will be remembered for his brilliant discovery of Raman effect for which he received the Noble Prize in Physics in 1930. He explained the mystery of blue colour of sea water, optical phenomenon of diamond, gems, opals etc. He created the school of Physics and the Raman Research Institute, Bangalore. He founded the Indian Academy of Sciences and started the Indian Journal of Physics.

## 'Limitations of Big Bang theory'

Element abundance prediction is not found true. The universe has too much large scale structures, hence cannot be formed in a short period as mentioned in Big Bang. The local streaming motions of galaxies could not be explained by this theory. Area of 96% invisible dark matter could not be explained by this theory. ## 'Limitations of carbon dating method'

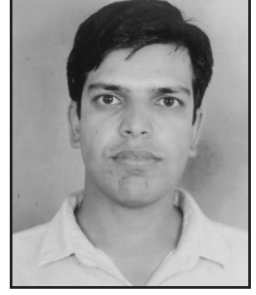
